Dear Congress Members,

As dedicated future, current, and former professionals across healthcare, mental health, social work, public health, and advocacy, we are writing today to urge you to stop any cuts, restructuring, or addition of bureaucratic red tape to the Medicaid program.

Serving on the frontlines in our healthcare system, we have seen firsthand the benefits that Medicaid brings to the state. It ensures that seniors receive long-term care support, 1.2 million children have access to critical developmental services, individuals with disabilities receive support and care necessary to live with autonomy and dignity, pregnant women obtain prenatal care without financial hardship, and low-wage workers stay healthy to support their families. Medicaid is more than a healthcare program — it is a lifeline for individuals, families, and communities in all of North Carolina.

In 2023, with broad bipartisan support, North Carolina passed and launched its Medicaid expansion program. Since that time, over 615,000 people from across our state have been able to enroll in this life-changing health coverage. They have accessed medical care, preventative screenings, dental work, and affordable prescription drugs, all without fear of medical debt. Now, we are deeply concerned that funding for this lifesaving program is under attack without thought about the profound and lasting impacts this will have on our patients and our hospitals, especially in rural areas.

According to a recent Forbes article,¹ North Carolina is the most expensive state in the country for healthcare, making broad access to health coverage through Medicaid even more critical for our patients with lower incomes. The healthcare crisis in this country must be addressed in an intentional manner that improves access to quality care and is cost-aware. Rushing these decisions will disproportionately impact low- and middle-income earners who make up the majority of your constituents.

We urge you to protect Medicaid so that our patients can continue to get the care they need to provide for themselves and their families. We are firmly against per capita caps, block grants, and changes to the federal match — especially the 90% for Medicaid expansion. We also oppose work

Any cuts to Medicaid will cause significant and irreversible harm to the millions of North Carolinians who rely on it for health coverage. Please stand up for your constituents and reject Medicaid cuts.
